In our September 2000 report, we cited the Boards concerns about Review of Overlapping overlapping language services and its plans to address this issue in Language Services subsequent iterations of the language service review process. In our July Implemented 2003 report we again raised the issue of language service overlap and content duplication between VOA and the surrogates. We also noted that while the Boards strategic plan identified overlap as a challenge, it failed to answer questions about when it is appropriate to broadcast VOA and surrogate programming in the same language. The Board has responded to our observations and recommendations by incorporating a review of overlapping services in its language service review process for 2003. The Board developed several approaches to dealing with overlap. For example, services can be merged by having one service subsume another (as was the case with Radio Farda). A second approach is to run alternating services, as is the case with the Afghanistan...
