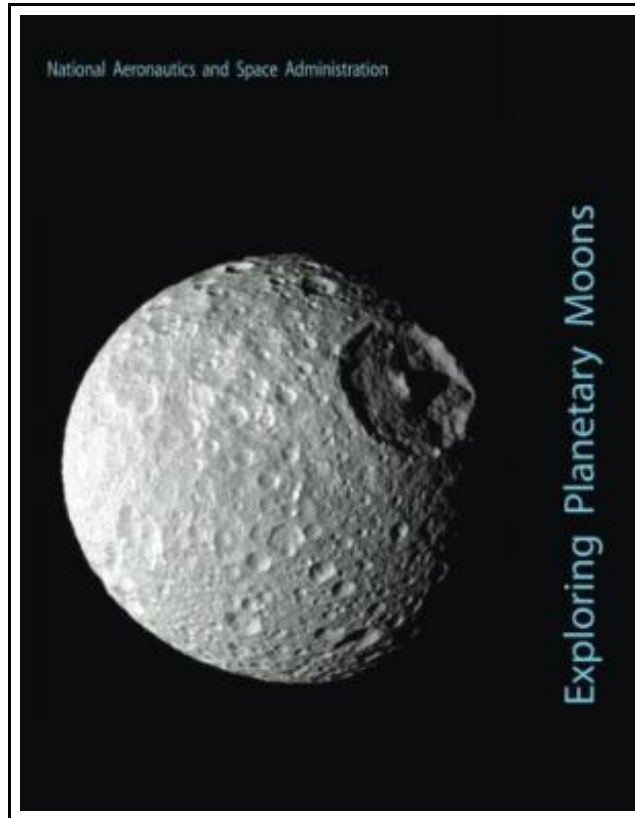

For example, if a Cook wants to enlarge a recipe to feed 25 people rather than 12, the original ingredients need to be scaled up using proportional techniques.
